Compliant	Consistent with mandatory laws and regulations	
Conformance	Consistent with voluntary standards and associated requirements	
Scope of the CoC	Clarifies 'scope' relates to topics covered by the CoC Standard

Seafood fraud	Deliberate misrepresentation of seafood products (or ingredients), for financial or economic gain, with the intention of deceiving the customer
