The Coalition works to enable collaborative action to achieve a decent standard of living for working people and their families worldwide. The Coalition is committed to using the [Anker Methodology](#) to provide living wage benchmarks that are publicly available.

What is an Anker Research Institute living wage benchmark?

An ARI living wage benchmark is an estimate of the cost of a basic but decent lifestyle for a worker and his / her family in a particular place. More information on the methodology behind the benchmarks can be found [here](#).

What are Anker Research Institute reference values and subnational estimates?

In addition to living wage benchmarks, the Anker Research Institute has developed two associated types of studies (reference values and subnational estimates), that enable coverage of a wider range of locations by considering additional secondary data. Any of these Anker studies (benchmarks, reference values and subnational estimates), may be used when assessing living wage according to ASC requirements.
